WINEMAKING PROCESS:

GRAPES ARE HARVESTED DURING THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER. THEY ARE LATER FERMENTED IN STAINLESS STEEL AND THEN AGED FOR NINE MONTHS IN FRENCH OAK, 25% OF WHICH ARE NEW BARRELS, AND THE REST ARE SECOND USE.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% PINOT NOIR

TASTING NOTES:

NOTES OF FRESH RASPBERRIES, RIPE CHERRY AND BLACK PLUMS. HINTS OF TOAST FROM THE OAK AGEING. ON THE PALATE THE WINE IS ROUND AND SUBTLE WITH WELL-INTEGRATED TANNINS AND GREAT ACIDITY AND LONG FINISH. GREAT AGEING POTENTIAL.

GREAT WINE TO PAIR WITH SOFT CHEESES, PASTAS, RISOTTOS AND POULTRY DISHES.
